

7th Grade Supply List 2020-2021

Toolkit Items - Students should label all toolkit items with their name. Students should assemble this toolkit before the first day of school. Students are responsible for replenishing items as needed during the school year.

- Sturdy pencil pouch / box that fits all the following:
 - 12 assorted colored pencils
 - protractor
 - scissors
 - pencils and erasers
 - blue or black pen(s)
 - a red pen
 - highlighter(s)
 - glue stick
 - black sharpie
 - black dry erase marker
 - earbuds or headphones with microphone capability, auxiliary jack only, no Bluetooth

Personal Items - These items will be kept by the student for personal use during the year.

- One 3-inch binder with clear front sleeve cover
- 8 plastic binder tab dividers with pockets (see “Avery 8-Tab Plastic Binder Dividers with Pockets” on Amazon for example)
- Agenda/assignment book (optional, Students must record their homework every night. Students may use their computers (Schoology calendar or the Sticky Notes program) to record homework, or they may use a paper agenda/assignment book. If purchasing a paper book, we recommend one that includes large boxes for each day in a weekly view style. Students should not choose a calendar showing only a monthly view, as this will not provide enough space for writing down daily assignments. 8"x10" size is recommended.)
- 1 pack lined paper
- 1 pack graph paper
- TI 30XIIS calculator (optional, only needed if handheld calculator is preferred over online calculator)
- USB flash drive for schoolwork only
- USB plug in computer mouse
- Protective sleeve for laptop
 - NOT a laptop bag with pockets and a strap – just a protective, soft, Neoprene sleeve that can be slid into a backpack
 - Laptop has approximately a 14-15" screen
 - Students can wait until they are given their laptop to purchase this item for sizing purposes
- Clear reusable water bottle (NO glass)
- Pedometer, please select from one of the following three choices:
 - Students may use an Apple Watch, Fit Bit or another wearable step counting device they already own
 - Students may purchase their own wearable pedometer (search “FITstep2 Pedometer” for example)
 - Student may purchase a pedometer from DRSS for \$12, please use [this link](#) to order your pedometer by August 3rd

- Students may be asked to purchase 1 or 2 novels during the school year for personal use to limit the sharing of books between students.
