## **Parking Regulations and Agreement Form**

Student's over 16 with a valid driver's license may choose to drive to DRSS with parental permission. Driving to school is a privilege, not a right. No student will be permitted to drive a car to school without turning in the signed parking Regulations and Agreement Form along with the application for Student Parking/Driving. Please be aware that the completion of these forms does not guarantee parking privileges for the student. Forms are available at the school office or can be found on the school website: <a href="https://www.daytonstemschool.org">www.daytonstemschool.org</a>. There is a \$20.00 charge associated with the Parking Regulations and Agreement Form. An additional \$30.00 charge for seniors who wish to decorate their parking spot a.nd receive preferential parking locations.

When permission is granted, it will be under the following conditions:

- The vehicle driven to school must display the DRSS parking permit from the rear-view mirror.
- Upon arrival at school, the car is to be parked and locked for the duration of the student's school day. Should the car be driven off campus without permission, the student will lose driving privileges and will be subject to the provisions of the Code of Conduct.
- DRSS is not responsible for damage to the vehicle, while parked on campus.
- Students are **not** permitted to leave the school during their lunchtime.
- The laws of the State of Ohio and the City of Kettering are to be observed at all times.
- Please note that students under the age of 17 are not permitted to have more than one non-family member in the car with them while they are driving, unless their parent or legal guardian accompanies them. This is a State of Ohio law.
- The school cannot assume responsibility for the driver or their passengers.
- Students must show evidence that they have auto insurance and a valid Ohio Driver's license.
- At the conclusion of the school day, drivers must exit properly. At no time should students drive between parked cars or cut through the lot. *Inappropriate driving will result in loss of your driving privilege.*
- Prior written parental notification must be turned in to the main office before a student will be allowed to leave DRSS before the end of the school day.

Please note, when you decide to drive to school, it becomes your responsibility to get to school on time. Late arrivals will not be excused due to a flat tire, engine trouble, traffic, or other car related excuses.

## **Registration Process**

- Any DRSS Student may register for a parking/driving privileges if they have the following items:
  - o Valid Ohio Driver's License
  - o Proof of Insurance
  - o Vehicle Registration
  - Signed Parking Regulations and Agreement Form
  - o \$20.00 yearly parking fee
  - \$30.00 Senior decorating fee (optional)
- Students may not drive to school until the signed Agreement form and application are returned to Mrs.
   Short
