Fall 2020 - COVID Response

All extracurricular activities, clubs, committees, groups and organizations will follow the Tier System for hosting meetings, activities, and events unless stated otherwise by Administration.

Tier 1 - School-sponsored groups may meet on campus and observe space capacities

Tier 2 - Staff-led groups may meet virtually; advisor may seek approval to meet on campus

Tier 3 - Student-led groups will not be active in the fall and re-evaluated for spring semester

BASIC GUIDELINES:

- All building-wide protocols outlined in Restart STEM Guide will be followed after school
- Virtual meetings are highly recommended for all student group meetings, when possible
- Tier 1 and 2 groups may only meet in person during Plan A of the Restart STEM Guide
- All group advisors must submit the Club Application to be active during fall semester
- Student groups may not begin meeting in-person or virtually until September 8th
